About the position

We are looking for an experienced, full-time software engineer to join our team. The primary roles and responsibilities of this position include:

- Planning, designing, and implementing software systems
- Working closely with clients, users, stakeholders, and other developers to ensure the final products serve their needs
- Managing issues, code and design review, and QA/QC for a project
- Supervising and mentoring other developers

We are a cohesive group of scientists, geospatial analysts, spatial modelers, and software engineers. CBI's software team works closely with other staff as well as with external clients to design and build custom, innovative software.
